

PHOENIX, Ariz. – The brackets were released for the 2018 Nike Tournament of Champions on Tuesday afternoon.

Bradley Central was placed in the Joe Smith bracket will take on Beaverton (Ore.) on Wednesday Dec. 19 at 7:30 p.m. eastern time.

This division features 16 teams from eight different states (Ariz., Calif., Colo., Fla., N.Y., Tenn., and Utah). The bracket has 32 games with a champion being crowned on Saturday at 4:30 p.m. eastern time.

The matchups begin at noon eastern on Wednesday with St. Mary's (Calif.) and Xavierian (N.Y.) while the Bearettes will take on the winner of Highlands Ranch (Colo.) and East (Utah).

Bradley Central is currently ranked 87th in the nation according to maxpreps.com national rankings (2nd in the state and in AAA). Beaverton (Ore.) comes in at 4,718, Highlands Ranch (Colo.) is 24th, East (Utah) 1,006, Valley Vista (Ariz.) 65th, Redondo Union (Calif.) 553, St. Mary's (Calif.) 2,935, Xavierian (N.Y.) (Not found on maxpreps.com), Sacramento (Calif.) 88th, Perry (Ariz.) 1,801, Cherry Creek (Colo.) (Not found on maxpreps.com), Lake Highland (Fla.) 217, Dillard (Fla.) 71st, Seton Catholic (Ariz.) 550, Carondelet (Calif.) (Not found on maxpreps.com), and Mater Dei (Calif.) is 14th in the experts poll and 61st in the national rankings.
