

CLEVELAND, Tenn. -- The Bradley Central Bearettes defeated Soddy-Daisy 79-17 on Tuesday evening inside Jim Smiddy Arena.

Bradley opened up the scoring on an 11-0 run before Soddy scored their first point of the night on a Katie Hamby free throw. The Trojans scored one more point in the quarter on a Baylie Davis free throw with 13 seconds to go in the first before the Bearettes exploded on a 28-point run to end the first half up 49-2.

Bradley was then able to double their opponent's second-half scoring 30-15 to wrap up the dominating win.

Jamaryn Blair exploded to tie a career-high 22 points on the night. Anna Roberts cracked double digits throwing in 11 points while Cambree Mayo rounded out the two-digit scorers for Bradley with 10.

Anna Walker led the battle of the boards with seven rebounds as Bradley won the rebounding war 39-26, including 21 offensive rebounds.

Soddy-Daisy was paced by Hemby with nine points while Davis led the team with seven rebounds.

The Bearettes were able to force a season-high 33 turnovers on yet another high 20 steals. Bradley was able to set season highs in points scored (79), field goals made (27), and assists (18).
